

## Year 6 Curriculum Slice - Summer Term 2018

This term Year 6 will start by preparing for their forthcoming SATs beginning on Monday 14th May 2018. After SATs we shall continue to develop our mathematical skills and further develop our writing portfolio. There will be a strong cross curricular approach where children can apply their skills in a variety of ways from making business plans to reciting poetry. We shall also be focussing on a science topic called 'Out of This World' which focusses on Space and your child will be given the opportunity to do some research about a part of the topic which particularly takes their interest. We shall also further build on our geography skills by learning about international time zones and the formation of continents. Children in Year 6 will be receiving Sex and Relationships Education. During PE we shall be developing our athletics and fielding skills.



Also after SATs we shall be preparing for our enterprise projects for Make A £1 Grow Week which starts on 21st May.

This term is important for preparing the children for the move to high school in September. We will be visited by all our feeder high schools during this term and they will speak to the staff and pupils. Your child will also have a transition visit to their high school and the schools will notify you of this date and their procedures. We will discuss with the children different issues relating to the move and help to answer any questions they may have.

At the end of the term Year 6 will put on a production for the parents as a celebration of their time at Mablins Lane. Time will be spent doing drama and creative arts over the preceding weeks.



We shall be participating in Primary College 2018 for two days at South Cheshire College on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> July.

Diaries still remain an important means of home - school communication in Year 6 and will need to be signed by a member of staff and a parent/carer weekly.
