History: Changes in our living memory, how our families have changes, how the area around the school have changed (fields to housing estates)

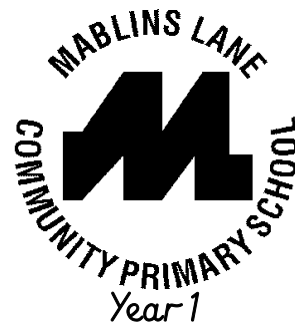

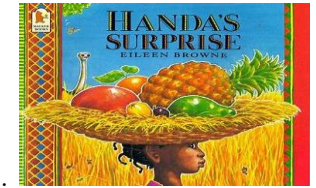
Context for learning

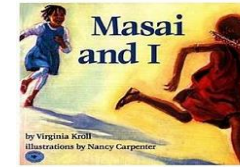


English
