

Drop Off and Collection

Although we have staggered start and end times to the school day it is still busy on Mablins Lane and Parkers Road between 08:30 –9:00 and 2:55 – 3:30. Please can I urge parents to:

- Walk to school wherever possible
- Stick to the drop off times for your year group
- DO NOT STOP ON THE ZIG ZAG LINES
- DO NOT drop off in the school gateways
- Park considerately on the surrounding roads
- Keep to 20 MPH on Mablins Lane and Parkers Road.
- DO NOT park opposite the junction to Wareham Drive on Mablins Lane, parked cars risk getting a ticket. This also caused an incident this week where a driver mounted the pavement and drove along the pavement through the bus stop area and then aggressively back on to the road the other side of the bus stop. The police were informed.

Covid-19

Miss Hickman, Mrs Walker, Mrs Kulikowski and Y4SJH continue to remain at home following the positive case

The guidance for Covid still gives the main symptoms as;

- New and persistent dry cough
- High temperature
- Loss of taste /smell

Should your child present with any of these symptoms they should **not go out**, but you should **seek a test**. Children should **NOT** return to school if they are presenting with any of the symptoms. If in doubt always seek medical advice.

If your child is ill and unable to come to school then please telephone the school, leaving a message on the absence line.

Covid- 19 Telephone Number

If your child has a Covid test and it is positive you must inform the school immediately by calling our Covid telephone line on:

This number is **ONLY** for reporting a positive test. It will be available during school time, during the evenings and at weekends.

If we receive a call on this number we will then follow Cheshire East and Public Health England (PHE) guidance on next steps, but by calling us on this number it will allow us to act in a swifter manner. Following the call your child must self-isolate for at least 10 days from when symptoms started (or from day of test if no symptoms) unless PHE advise to the contrary.
