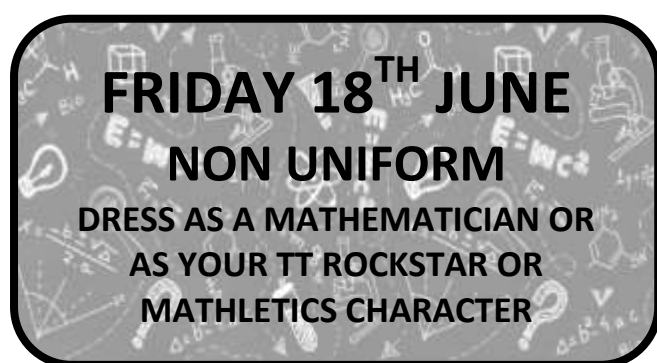
Maths Day – Friday 18th JUNE

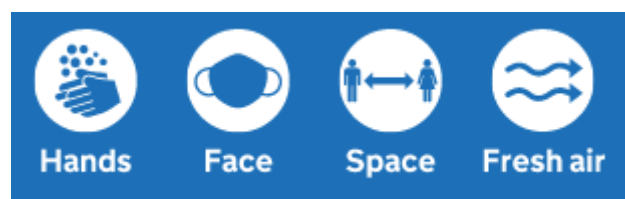
previously offered ice lollies at lunchtime. Due to restrictions we do not plan to have lollies on sale this year.

COVID

Unfortunately the number of positive cases due to Variant D has increased significantly in Cheshire East. ALL restrictions remain in place in school and we ask that parents continue to support us by following the guidance. Further testing facilities have been opened across the town providing increased access for families. If your child shows any symptoms then please do not send them in to school.

We currently have staff members who have been contacted by Track and Trace and need to isolate, but fortunately we have NO positive cases within the direct school community.

Positive Cases

A protocol is in place should a positive case be reported and that class/year group will be isolated immediately. Parents will be contacted and a 10-day isolation period will be implemented. It is vital that parents support us by passing on important information quickly. Should a pupil or any close family member show any symptoms then it is important NOT to come to school. Please notify us of the situation and we can take appropriate action.

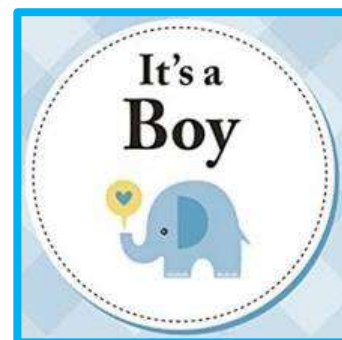
