#### COVID

We almost made it  $\odot$  It was with very much regret that we have had to close two year groups this week.

We were notified of 3 positive cases this week, 2 in Y6 and 1 in Y3. Following guidance from the Local Authority this has meant the closure of all Y3 and Y6 classes. We are absolutely devastated. We had great plans for the last week of term and are now busy trying to put things in place to support our Y3 and Y6 pupils over the coming

days. Online sessions have been made available and the teachers are communicating to let parents know when these are.

Our Y3 and Y6 departments have been deep cleaned and we have made arrangements for the collection of possessions. Any personal items will be retained until September if collection is not possible.

The number of positive cases due to Variant D has continued to rise again this week across Cheshire East. As variant 'D' has a much greater transmission rate ALL restrictions remain in place in school and we ask that parents continue to support us by following the guidance.

# RESTRICTIONS WILL REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL THE END OF TERM ON TUESDAY 20<sup>TH</sup> JULY.

- FACE MASKS must be worn on site
- SOCIAL DISTANCING 2m social distancing measure remain in place
- ONE WAY SYSTEM operational across the school site





We will only be allowing essential visitors in to school over the coming days. Staff are taking regular LFT tests and responding to results accordingly.

- If your child does show any symptoms then please do not send them in to school.
- If anybody in your house receives a positive result then please isolate and do not come to school.
- A positive LFT result should be followed by a PCR test and pupils should not come to school until a negative PCR result is received.

We currently have several members of staff who are isolating. It is very difficult for us to give advance notice for changes of staff in these cases, but please be assured that any staff who need to isolate do so immediately and cover is provided following the safest options.

### **Positive Cases**

A protocol is in place should a positive case be reported and that class/year group will be isolated immediately. Parents will be contacted and a 10-day isolation period will be implemented. It is vital that parents support us by passing on important information quickly. Should a pupil or any close family member show any symptoms then it is important **NOT** to come to school. Please notify us of the situation and we can take appropriate action.





### **LOCKDOWN GUIDANCE:**

### England moves to Step 4 from 19 July

While cases are high and rising, everybody needs to continue to act carefully and remain cautious. This is why we are keeping in place key protections at step 4 from 19 July:

- testing when you have symptoms and targeted asymptomatic testing in education, high risk workplaces and to help people manage their personal risk.
- isolating when positive or when contacted by NHS Test and Trace.
- border quarantine: for all arriving from red list countries and for those people not fully vaccinated arriving from amber list countries.

- cautious guidance for individuals, businesses and the vulnerable whilst prevalence is high including:
- whilst Government is no longer instructing people to work from home if they can, Government would expect and recommend a gradual return over the summer
- Government expects and recommends that people wear face coverings in crowded areas such as public transport;
- being outside or letting fresh air in
- minimising the number, proximity and duration of social contacts.
- encouraging and supporting businesses and large events to use the NHS Covid Pass in high risk settings. The Government will work with organisations where people are likely to be in close proximity to others outside their household to encourage the use of this. If sufficient measures are not taken to limit infection, the Government will consider mandating certification in certain venues at a later date.
