
Dear Parents and Children,

<u>Global Awareness Week – Open</u> <u>Morning</u>



This week is Global Awareness Week in school. All classes will be looking at Global related issues over the week.

On Wednesday morning we are holding an OPEN MORNING where parents are invited to share in some 'plastic free school activities'. We've been discussing ideas in school such as reducing the single use plastic/products being brought into school by the children. We would encourage parents to send packed lunches in reusable hard plastic lunchboxes with compartments, so there is no need for plastic wrap etc. Also if yoghurt is brought in, consider recyclable pots instead of frubes and other yoghurt tubes (non-recyclable). Some of the children already have no plastic waste at all in their lunchboxes.

Parents are invited on Wednesday 19th June from 09:15 to 11:00 and should wait by the entrance door close to the main hall. There will be activities in the main hall and in classrooms. Refreshments will be served but in our bid to be a plastic free school we are asking parents to bring their own reusable cup if they wish to have a drink.

We look forward to seeing as many parents as possible.
