### **Forest Schools at Mablins Lane**



Year 2 had an amazing time in Forest Schools this week learning how to use tools safely!



#### COVID

We currently have four children out of school because they have received a positive PCR. (At the time of writing.) We also have four children waiting for PCR results. No staff are currently absent due to Covid reasons. Numbers are still very high across Cheshire East and we ask that families are vigilant.

Public Health provided us with some additional information and additional measures to take prior to half term. These remain current and we ask that parents apply the guidance:

- If your child does show any symptoms at all then please do not send them in to school. This includes heavy colds and headaches.
- If anybody in your house receives a positive result then please follow current guidance on isolation.
   Do not come to school if you are positive.
- The advice is for families to take twice weekly LFT tests where possible to enable positive cases to be identified earlier.
- A positive LFT result should be followed by a PCR test and pupils should not come to school until a negative PCR result is received.

At all times we advise caution and consideration.

**FACE MASKS** – we are still encouraging families to wear a face covering whilst on site.



We are still looking to keep visitors on site to a minimum to reduce the risk of transmission.

**SOCIAL DISTANCING** — we are still encouraging families to observe the 2m social distancing measures, particularly whilst waiting on the playground. It is requested that only **1 adult per family** comes on site to collect children and that they stick to the drop off and collection times. At the end of the day we ask that families move quickly from the site and disperse accordingly.



**ONE WAY SYSTEM** – this remains in operation across the school site.


If your child has a **Covid test and it is positive** you must inform the school immediately by calling our Covid telephone line on:

### Mid-day Assistant Job Vacancy

We are looking to appoint a Midday Assistant to supervise
