COVID

We currently have four children out of school because they have received a positive PCR. (At the time of writing.) We also have three children waiting for PCR results. Two members of staff are currently absent due to Covid reasons. Numbers are still very high across Cheshire East and we ask that families are vigilant.

Public Health provided us with some additional information and additional measures to take prior to half term. These remain current and we ask that parents apply the guidance:

- If your child does show any symptoms at all then please do not send them in to school. This includes heavy colds and headaches.
- If anybody in your house receives a positive result then please follow current guidance on isolation. Do not come to school if you are positive.
- The advice is for families to take twice weekly LFT tests where possible to enable positive cases to be identified earlier.
- A positive LFT result should be followed by a PCR test and pupils should not come to school until a negative PCR result is received.


At all times we advise caution and consideration.

FACE MASKS – we are still encouraging families to wear a face covering whilst on site.



We are still looking to keep visitors on site to a minimum to reduce the risk of transmission.

SOCIAL DISTANCING – we are still encouraging families to observe the 2m social distancing measures, particularly whilst waiting on the playground. It is requested that only **1 adult per family** comes on site to collect children and that they stick to the drop off and collection times. At the end of the day we ask that families move quickly from the site and disperse accordingly.

Message from our PCSO

Dear Parents/ Guardians at Mablins Lane Community Primary School,



I am writing to you to raise a few issues that have been brought to our attention by the school and from residents in the local area.

School Parking - The topic that has been top of the list for years. We at Cheshire Police and the Parish Council have received numerous messages on

different platforms from fellow parents and local residents regarding school parking. We understand that drop off/ collection times are stressful and ask parents to set off sooner to offer more time to find a safe place to park. For those following our social media pages may have seen, we do issue Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) for unlawful parking and shall continue to do so which is a £30 fine (The last thing we want to do on the run up to Christmas).

'Squid Games' being played in the school playground - Before we continue, the last thing we wish to discourage is the students engaging in playground games and enjoying their break time. However, we ask that parents remain mindful what their child is exposed to and what they are viewing and the computer games they are playing so that inappropriate games aren't being played in the school playground.
