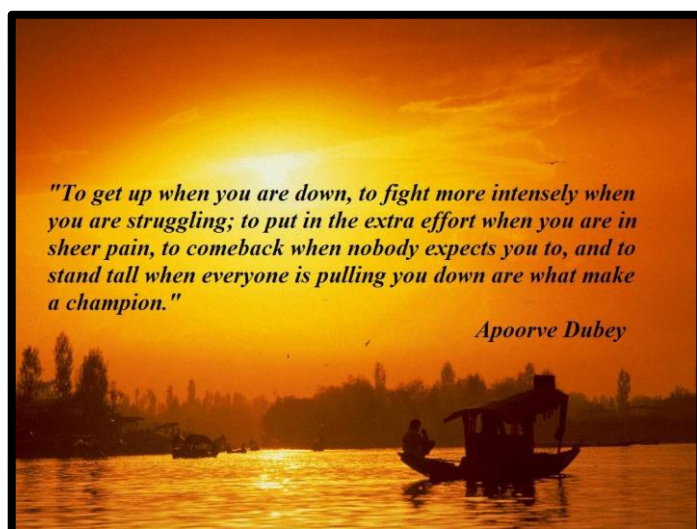


Mablins Lane Community Primary School Newsletter ~ 11th February 2022

COVID Update

We currently have **6 children** out of school because they have received a positive test. (At the time of writing.)

Five members of staff are also currently absent due to positive Covid results.

PLEASE HELP EVERYBODY TO SAFE AND FOLLOW THIS GUIDANCE.

FACE MASKS – All staff will continue to wear a face covering in communal areas of the school. Visitors are being kept to an absolute minimum and year groups are working independently.

SOCIAL DISTANCING – we are still encouraging families to observe the 2m social distancing measures, particularly whilst waiting on the playground. It is requested that only **1 adult per family** comes on site to collect children and that they stick to the drop off and collection times. At the end of the day we ask that families move quickly from the site and disperse accordingly.

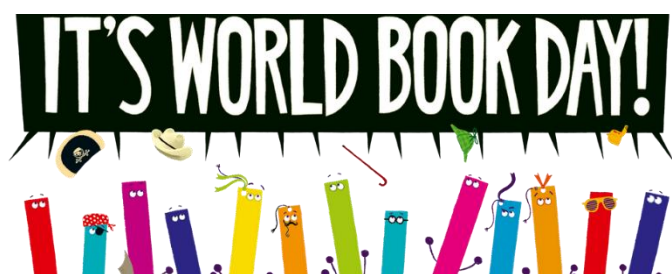
World Book Day/Green Week
