Following new guidance, the school Attendance Policy is also being reviewed and updated.

Drop off – Parking

We have been **urging** parents in all our recent newsletters to think very carefully about where they drop off and park their cars in the vicinity of the school.

Following an accident where a pupil had their foot run over, the Health and Safety Executive have met with us and an action plan has been drawn up to support the safety of pupils around the school.

Members of the school team will be outside in high-viz jackets monitoring the parking situation at the start of the

day. Registration numbers will be taken where vehicles are parked inappropriately (including dropping off), mounting the kerb or stopping on the zig zag lines. Parents will be contacted and then the information will be passed to the Police.

The Parish Council have a 'speed awareness' group who have offered support to the school. Several parents have also approached offering their support to monitor the situation.



We have this week put up parking warning banners which we will be adding to with more after the Easter break. The school Council have also written to local councilors, along with our Governors.

Please be reminded that the Eight Farmers pub car park has been made available for school drop off / pick up parking. Many thanks to Lisa and her team at the pub for allowing us to use this facility.

REMEMBER:

PARENTS SHOULD NOT BE DROPPING CHILDREN OFF AT THE FRONT OF SCHOOL ON THE YELLOW ZIG ZAG LINES!

ALSO: During the period of drop off and collection vehicles should adhere to the "20's plenty" slogan. I have witnessed many vehicles in Mablins Lane exceeding this speed. Parents are dropping children and then 'speeding' away. This is dangerous for all concerned. Please keep your speed low and our children safe.



These measures are in place to keep ALL of our children safe and for no other reason. Sadly we have had to suffer much verbal abuse which is totally unnecessary and unacceptable. We must inform parents that this will not be tolerated. Any abuse will be reported to the police.

All we ask is that people park safely. Thank you.

COVID Update

Unfortunately we still have a number of cases in school. Currently 15 children and 2 members of staff have tested positive. We have 4 cases in one class which is just below the outbreak threshold.

If your child tests positive we urge caution. If they are unwell then they should remain at home until they feel better as they would with any illness. Certainly if they are coughing, have a temperature or have a very runny nose we **would not** advise that they attend school. If we get 5 cases in any class we will inform parents and at that point would ask that children who have tested positive or who live in a house where somebody has tested positive, remain at home for at least 5 days.

The rules change again today, therefore after Easter new guidance will be issued. LFT tests will no longer be readily available making it less easy to test and confirm whether you are positive. We will be urging anybody with symptoms to stay away from school and seek a PCR test.


If your child has a **Covid test and it is positive**, please still inform the school **by calling our Covid telephone line on:**


