


Mablins Lane Community Primary School Newsletter ~ 22nd April 2022

COVID Update

The rules changed as we broke up for the Easter holiday. A letter was sent on Tuesday giving families the updated guidance. If children test positive then please continue to let us know via the Covid line. If your child is poorly then please keep them at home. If they test positive but are symptom free the guidance is to stay at home for 3 days as a child and 5 days as an adult. If your child does test positive then we continue to urge caution.
