
Next week we have another bank holiday, so a four day week again! We hope that you enjoy the extra day ©

Year 6 Theatre Visit



Last week Year 6 visited the Coliseum in Oldham to watch a production of The Jungle Book. This is one of the first visits out of school and the children were a credit to themselves and the school. Year 2 SATs

On Tuesday Year 2 will be starting their formal assessment process. This is not 'testing', but the children will be completing focussed activities in small groups in order to determine how much progress the children have made. It is important that Year 2 children are in school next week, but if they are ill there will be opportunities to complete the assessments before the half term break.

Year 6 SATs

Week beginning 9th May, Year 6 will have their SATs week. This is a more formal process with children sitting tests on a designated day. It is vital that the children are in school as tests cannot be taken at a later date. If any child misses a test it is just recorded as an absent code. The test timetable is as follows:

Monday 9th May - SPAG and spelling

Tuesday 10th May - Reading

Wednesday 11th May – Maths paper 1 + 2

Thursday 12th May – Maths paper 3

All tests will be undertaken in the morning sessions. The children will be invited in to school for breakfast in the main hall in preparation for the testing timetable.

Future overnight visits

The next overnight visit will be in June for Y3 who missed their visit in Year 2. Each class will be spending one night away at the local Tattenhall Centre.

Current Y5 have 2 visits in the pipeline for Y6 (same as the offer to current Y6). They will have a one night stay at the Tattenhall Centre in October and then a week in the Lake District in May 2023.

It has been difficult to re-schedule and plan all these visits, but we now feel that we are getting 'caught-up' and the children have had a good offer of overnight stays.

Parking update

We continue to monitor parking around the school at the start and end of the school day. Many thanks to those families who have shown their support.

There have been some issues this week with the community support group taking photos and videos of the children entering school. As a school we have not directed this action. Whilst I understand what the action group are trying to do, I also understand the safeguarding issues raised by parents. I have looked at some of the footage and have seen some dreadful examples of parking and dropping off. If all our parents considered the safety of the children and parked safely then there would be no need for the action group to be outside school at all.

I have spoken to the PCSO and the Parish Council who continue to support us, and ask that parents do the same. Please be reminded that the Eight Farmers pub car park has been made available for school drop off / pick up

parking. Many thanks to Lisa and her team at the pub for allowing us to use this facility.
