Year 6 SATs Timetable

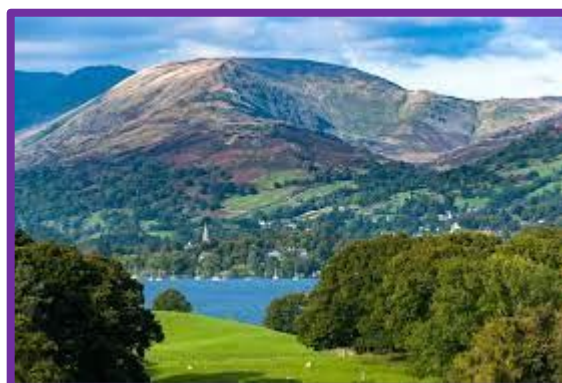
The test timetable is as follows:

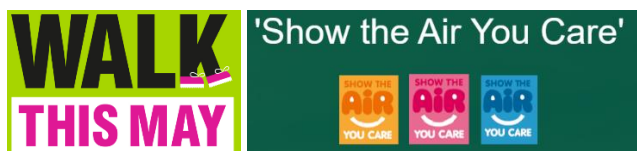
