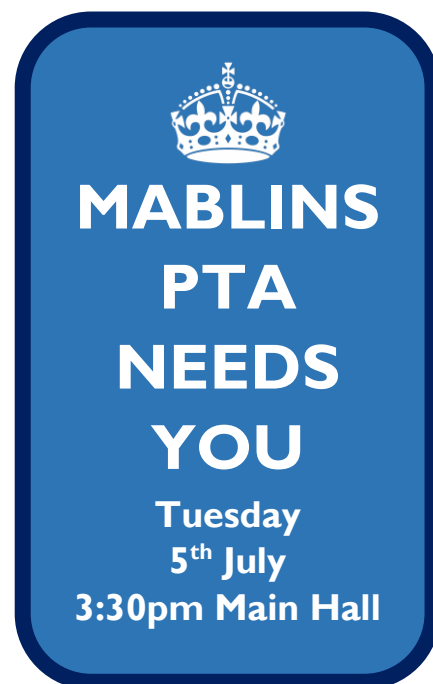
If you were- Mrs.Barwick and Mrs.King would love you to come and join us and have a look at the children's work that was stored in the capsule- yours may be in there too.

Also please remember that staff are only trying to keep children, parents and members of the public safe. We ask for your understanding and kindness at drop off and pick up times.



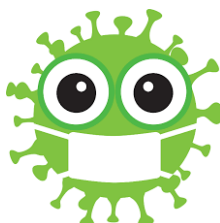
Drop Off – Pick Up

Please can we remind parents that they should not just drop children at the gate in the morning if they are running late?
