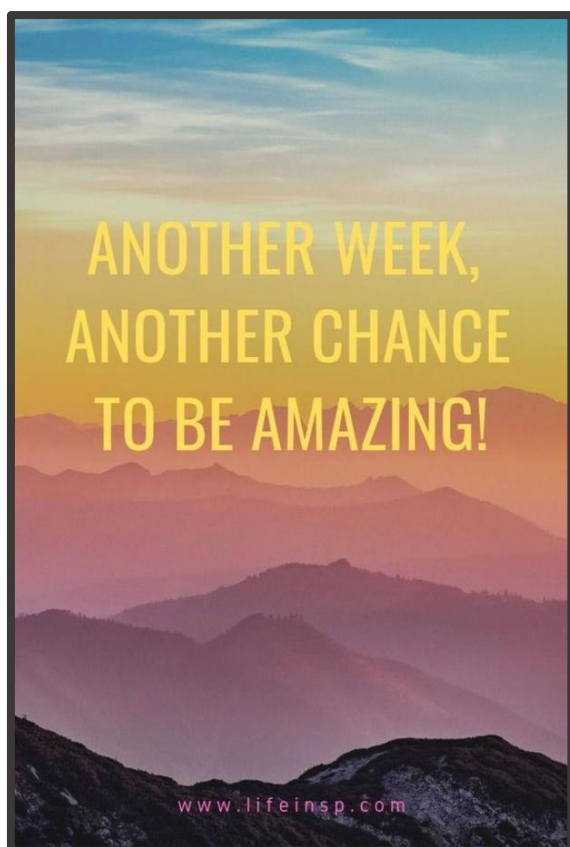


## Newsletter ~ 7<sup>th</sup> October 2022

### Parent meetings

We plan to hold our first autumn term parent appointments after school on **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October** and during the day of **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October** which is a school INSET Day.

Appointments will be held via TEAMS (using your child's Teams account) or by telephone if this is more convenient. Each appointment will be a 10 minute slot and will focus on how the children have settled into their new year groups and classes. ## COVID

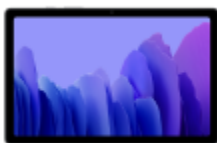
We must be mindful that Covid has not gone away. This week we have 3 members of staff who are absent because they have tested positive and 2 children.

- If your child does show any symptoms at all then please do not send them in to school.
- If anybody in your house receives a positive result then that person should isolate and should not come to school.
- Please be vigilant where there are positive cases in the household.

The guidance is 5 days isolation for adults and 3 days for children. Thank you for your support.

## Tablets

A reminder tablets MUST be brought to school every day, charged and ready to use. We can charge tablets in school if necessary but obviously don't have the availability to charge all tablets at the same time!!!
