PTA EVENTS



COVID

We must be mindful that Covid has not gone away. This week we have another 3 members of staff who are absent because they have tested positive and 5 children.

- If your child does show any symptoms at all then please do not send them in to school.
- If anybody in your house receives a positive result then that person should isolate and should not come to school.

Please be vigilant where there are positive cases in the household.

The guidance is 5 days isolation for adults and 3 days for children. Thank you for your support.

Reporting Absences

If your child is sick or absent for any reason, please report the absence to the School Office by either leaving a message with a reason for the absence on the School Sick Line or speaking to someone in the office. The telephone number is 01270 749908. If your child has



been vomitting then we request that they stay at home for 48 hours from the last instance of sickness.

Clubs

It has been lovely to see the return of a wide variety of clubs this half term. I have watched sport and dancing and have joined in with choir practice on a number of occasions. As the nights



get darker we will be reminding children of keeping safe and encourage parents to collect their children where possible.

Some parents are driving in to the school car park to collect their children at the end of a club. This is leading to some congestion and is not always safe for the children waiting to be collected. Where possible could we ask that parents park outside school and walk to the entrance to collect. This will help to keep all children safe. Thank you.
