


Mabins Lane Community Primary School Newsletter ~ 25th November 2022

Free school meals

Please check if you and your family are eligible to Income **Related Free School Meals.**

The shopping vouchers scheme is being extended and eligible families will get a total of £80 during the extended period, £60 before Christmas to cover October half term and December and then another £20 in January/February.

Checks can be made online at Free School Meals (cheshireeast.gov.uk) or parents can call 0300 123 5012.

Income Related Free School Meals is dependent on level household income/benefits received and should not be confused with Universal Infant Free School Meals.
