

Strep A and Scarlet Fever

There has been sad news in the press this week that 13 children have died from 'Strep A' infections across the country to date. We sent out information from the Local Authority earlier in the week and do ask parents to be vigilant.

I have to report that we have 1 confirmed case of 'Strep A' in Y4EC. We also have 3 confirmed cases of Scarlet Fever in Y2JMc, Y3SG and Y6AP.

We have reported these cases to the Local Authority as requested and await further guidance and direction on next steps. As soon as we receive this information we will notify families accordingly.



Winter respiratory illness

Many pupils and members of staff have been absent with a very nasty winter chest infection. We have further staff affected this week, but have again managed to cover in order that education has not been interrupted.

COVID

We must be mindful that Covid has not gone away. We again have several people off this week, both staff and pupils who have tested positive. Please help us all to stay well by following the guidance.

- If your child does show any symptoms at all then please do not send them in to school.
- If anybody in your house receives a positive result then that person should isolate and should not come to school.
- Please be vigilant where there are positive cases in the household.

The guidance is 5 days isolation for adults and 3 days for children. Thank you for your support.
