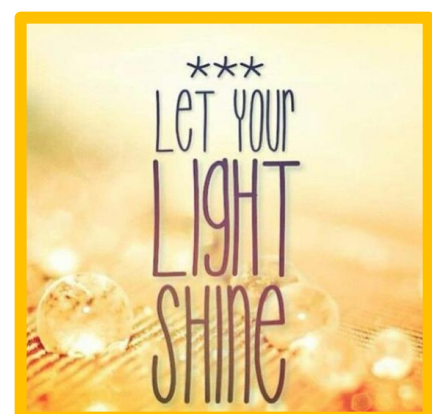




### **Rainbow Room Show/Shine Activities this week!**
