#### What is KiVa?

KiVa is a research- and evidence-based anti-bullying programme that has been developed in the University of Turku, Finland, with funding from the Finnish Ministry of Education and Culture. The strong effectiveness of KiVa has been proven scientifically through a large national randomized and controlled trial as well as several different studies. KiVa is being used around the world and it is the world's most studied anti-bullying programme.

#### How does KiVa work?


The goal of KiVa is to prevent bullying and to tackle the cases of bullying effectively. The program is based on decades of extensive research of bullying and its mechanisms. KiVa is based on three main elements: prevention, intervention and monitoring.

#### **Health Alert**

UKHSA has reported an increase in measles across the country and is encouraging people to check that they and their children have had two doses of the MMR vaccine. If children and young adults have missed these vaccinations in the past, they can get the vaccine now from GPs, particularly in light of the recent cases.

Anyone with symptoms is advised to stay at home and phone their GP/NHS 111 for advice.

Measles symptoms include:

- high fever
- sore, red, watery eyes
- coughing
- aching and feeling generally unwell
- a blotchy red brown rash, which usually appears after the initial symptoms.
