#### **Illness update**

We are pleased that EYFS was able to re-open on Monday following the Covid outbreak last week. We still have 6 members of staff absent, but have been able to cover all classes across the school. Please be vigilant with any signs and symptoms of illness. We ask that parents note the following guidance:

For the protection of all, we will revert to the following guidance for Covid.

- 3 days absence for children testing positive
- 5 days absence for adults testing positive,
- BUT if your child is still coughing, has a runny nose or is feeling unwell then they MUST remain at home.

Where children have cases of sickness and/or diarrhoea - we will continue to follow Infection Control guidance - which states that children must not return to school until 48hrs has passed since the last episode of sickness/diarrhoea.

#### **PTA AGM**

Due to illness it was agreed that the annual PTA AGM would be postponed and re-scheduled for after half term.

There will not be a Halloween Bingo this year but all efforts will go in to a Christmas Fair.

#### **Cheshire School Admissions 2024!**

Applications are now open for children starting primary school and transitioning to secondary

school. Parents are strongly advised to apply for three preferences.

Applications must be submitted to the child's home local authority by:

- 31 October 2023 for pupils moving up to High School in September 2024
- 15 January 2024 for pupils starting primary in September 2024

Parents still need to apply even if the child has a brother or sister already at the school or the child is attending a nursery/preschool attached to the school.

Some faith schools may also require parents and carers to submit a supplementary information form/confirmation of baptism. Further information about this will be available on the school's website.


