### Reminder: School Uniform

The [School Uniform Policy](#) has been updated and can be found on the school website. Please note that white/coloured trainers are not part of the uniform policy. Jewellery should be kept minimal – a simple watch and small stud earrings.

On days when the children are undertaking 'outdoor learning' they should wear warm layers and a waterproof coat. Jeans are not suitable for 'outdoor learning' sessions. Joggers or leggings are much better along with fleece jumpers. In the winter wellingtons, with warm socks, are the best footwear or walking style shoes/boots. All clothing should be named.

If items of clothing/footwear are borrowed from school, please return as soon as possible in order that other children can benefit. Thank you.

### Home School Agreement

We are asking parents and pupils to sign the Home School Agreement. Those parents who were unable to attend the Welcome Meetings have been sent a copy to sign at home and return to school. **PLEASE return this to the class teacher if you have not done so already. We still have some that are outstanding and are now overdue.**

### Medication

A reminder that ALL medication must now be sent to school via the school office. Please do not hand any medication to staff at the door. The correct medical forms should be completed in order that staff can administer to the correct prescription.

Year 5 will be leading the Harvest Celebration assembly on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October. As part of the celebration, we are collecting sustainable food items for the Chance Changing Lives Harvest Appeal. Each year group will have one box which some budding artists

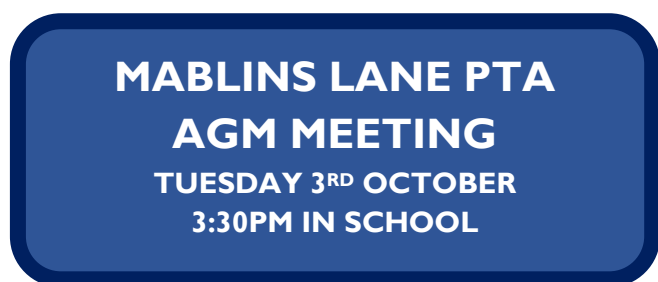


#### **PTA AGM**

### **Cheshire School Admissions 2024!**

Applications are now open for children starting primary school and transitioning to secondary school. Parents are strongly advised to apply for three preferences.

Applications must be submitted to the child's home local authority by:

- **31 October 2023 for pupils moving up to High School in September 2024**
- **15 January 2024 for pupils starting primary in September 2024**

Parents still need to apply even if the child has a brother or sister already at the school or the child is attending a nursery/preschool attached to the school.

Some faith schools may also require parents and carers to submit a supplementary information form/confirmation of baptism. Further information about this will be available on the school's website.
