#### **REMINDER: Illness guidance**

We ask that in order to keep everybody safe and well that  
 families are vigilant with any signs and symptoms of  
 illness. We ask that parents note the following guidance:

For the protection of all, we will revert to the following  
 guidance for Covid.

- 3 days absence for children testing positive
- 5 days absence for adults testing positive,
- BUT if your child is still coughing, has a runny nose or  
 is feeling unwell then they MUST remain at home.

Where children have cases of sickness and/or diarrhoea - we will continue to follow Infection Control guidance - which states **that children must not return to school until 48hrs has passed since the last episode of sickness/diarrhoea.**
