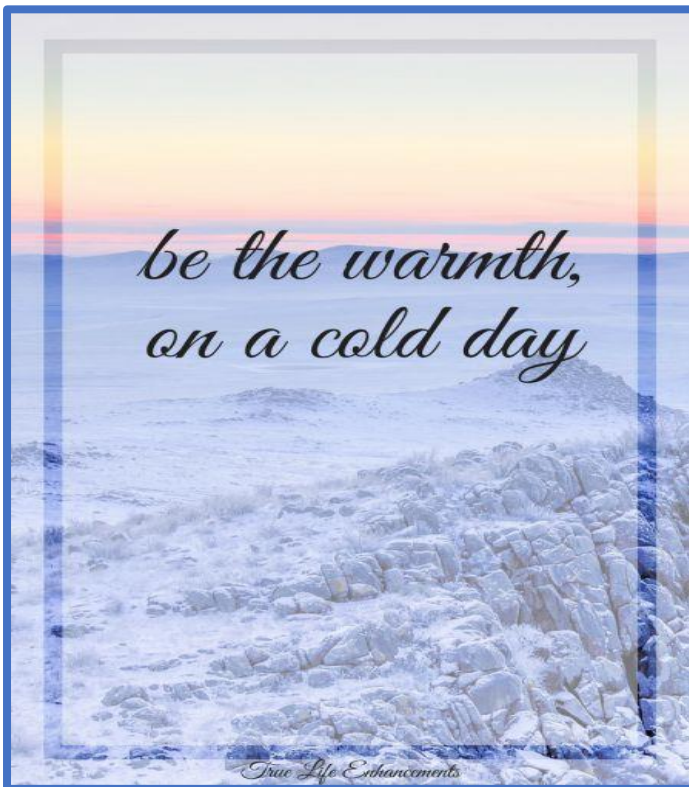


Mablins Lane Community Primary School Newsletter ~ 19th January 2024

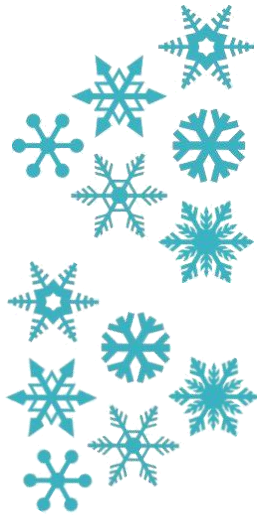

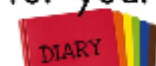
