


# Mablins Lane Community Primary School Newsletter ~ 19<sup>th</sup> January 2024

#### **Road Safety**

There have been a number of instances since returning to school where members of the public have called about having near misses with children crossing the road when walking to and from school. Crossing the road between parked cars and darting out into traffic has been reported twice. We will talk to children in school about Road Safety but would like parents to talk to children about safety when crossing the road.



- 1. Find a safe place to cross
- Stop just before you get to the kerb
- 3. Look all around for traffic and listen
- **4.** If traffic is coming, let it pass
- When it is safe, go straight across the road – do not run, keep looking and listening while you cross.
